RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CONTESTANTS

1.0 ELIGIBILITY FOR ENTRY

1.1 In order to enter the Miss Cayman Islands Competition (“the Competition”) the Contestant shall:

- (i) Be single and shall not have entered into any ceremony of marriage;
- (ii) Have attained the age of eighteen (18) years before they enter the Competition, and shall NOT have attained the age of twenty-six (26) years;
- (iii) Possess Caymanian Status;
- (iv) Be of good character with no criminal record save that convictions for minor traffic offences will not be taken into consideration;
- (v) Never have given birth to a child;
- (vi) Not be pregnant;
- (vii) Be possessed of charm, poise personality, and have beauty of face and figure, and shall maintain the recommended range of weight for her height recommended in the guidelines issued by any reputable Fitness Association including the American Fitness Association, and;
- (viii) Have graduated from High School.

2.0 OBLIGATIONS OF CONTESTANT

2:1 Each Contestant will be required to find her own sponsor, with assistance provided by the Miss Cayman Islands Committee (“the Committee”) if necessary.

2:2 Expenses in excess of those provided by the sponsor shall be the sole responsibility of the Contestant.

2:3 Each Contestant will be required to participate in all activities including without limitation, rehearsals, and functions organised by the Committee, and will comply with any instructions and directions issued by the Committee in respect thereof.

2:4 All rehearsals and functions associated with the contest shall be promptly and punctually attended. Any Contestant who misses two rehearsals without a reasonable explanation may be subject to disqualification.

2:5 Without prejudice to any other obligation of the Contestant, each Contestant hereby undertakes to remain eligible to participate in the Competition, throughout the period of the Competition in accordance with the criteria set out in clause 1 above.

2:6 *Each Contestant hereby agrees that in the event she becomes the Winner of the Competition (“the Winner”) she will have carefully received and understood and shall comply with the Rules of and Conditions of Participation for National Winners issued by Miss World (Jersey) Ltd. the organizers of the Miss World Competition and the Miss Universe L.P., LLLP organizers.*

2:7 *Each Contestant shall be advised of all the responsibilities expected of her by the Committee.*

3:0 AUTHORITY OF COMMITTEE

3:1 *If in the reasonable opinion of the Committee a Contestant no longer meets the eligibility requirements set out in clause 1 or is otherwise in breach of any of these Rules and Regulations, the Committee may in its absolute discretion disqualify a Contestant from continuing in the Competition.*

3:2 *In the event of any breach by the Winner of any of her obligations as set out in clause 4 below, the Committee may disqualify her from holding the Miss Cayman Islands title.*

4:0 OBLIGATIONS OF THE WINNER OF THE COMPETITION

4:1 *The Winner shall sign a contract with the Ministry of Tourism and the Miss Cayman Committee as soon as practical after being crowned, governing her reign as Miss Cayman.*

4:2 *The Winner shall for the period of one (1) year from the date of the Miss Cayman Islands Pageant until the date her successor is appointed:*

(i) *Not enter into any other beauty or similar contest, unless directed by the Committee;*

(ii) *Adhere to all rules of eligibility set out herein;*

(iii) *Make herself available for travel and such other engagements to be determined by the Committee;*

(iv) *Conduct herself with decorum and not commit any act of an immoral or illegal or other similar nature which in the reasonable opinion of the Committee will bring the National Winner or the Competition into disrepute or contempt.*

(v) *Comply with all of the terms and conditions set out in her contract with the Ministry of Tourism and the Miss Cayman Committee.*

5:0 OBLIGATIONS OF THE 1st RUNNER-UP OF THE COMPETITION

5:1 *The 1st Runner-up shall sign a contract with the Ministry of Tourism and the Miss Cayman Committee as soon or practical after the pageant, governing her responsibilities as 1st runner-up of Miss Cayman.*

5:2 *The 1st Runner-up shall for the period of one (1) year from the date of the Miss Cayman Islands Pageant until the date her successor is appointed:*

(i) *Not enter into any other beauty or similar contest, unless directed by the Committee;*

- (ii) *Adhere to all rules of eligibility set out herein;*
- (iii) *Make herself available for travel and such other engagements to be determined by the Committee;*
- (iv) *Conduct herself with decorum and not commit any act of an immoral or illegal or other similar nature which in the reasonable opinion of the Committee will bring the 1st Runner-up or the Competition into disrepute or contempt.*
- (v) *Comply with all of the terms and conditions set out in her contract with the Ministry of Tourism and the Miss Cayman Committee.*
